What it is Why it works

TREAX Pads is an interactive system of colored pads that respond to the touch of hands or feet and guide every movement with clear light feedback. It turns balance, coordination, reaction and weight-bearing work into structured, repeatable treatments.

Engagement is the point. When training feels purposeful and responsive, patients respond with better compliance, dosage and intensity which improves the clinical outcome.

Four core functions



Force Indication

Graded, real-time feedback for controlled weight-bearing weight shifting/transfer as well as anterior/posterior postural foot and body positioning. The lights adjust based on force and sustained position.



Random

Color signals train attention, coordination and visuomotor skills



Reaction

Timed targets sharpen response speed for fall prevention



Balance

Postural control, seated to single-leg stance

How it works

Configurations

Simple in practice

- 1 Place pads on floor or wall board
- 2 Select the function on the pad
- 3 Adjust distance, pace and pattern

Floor and wall

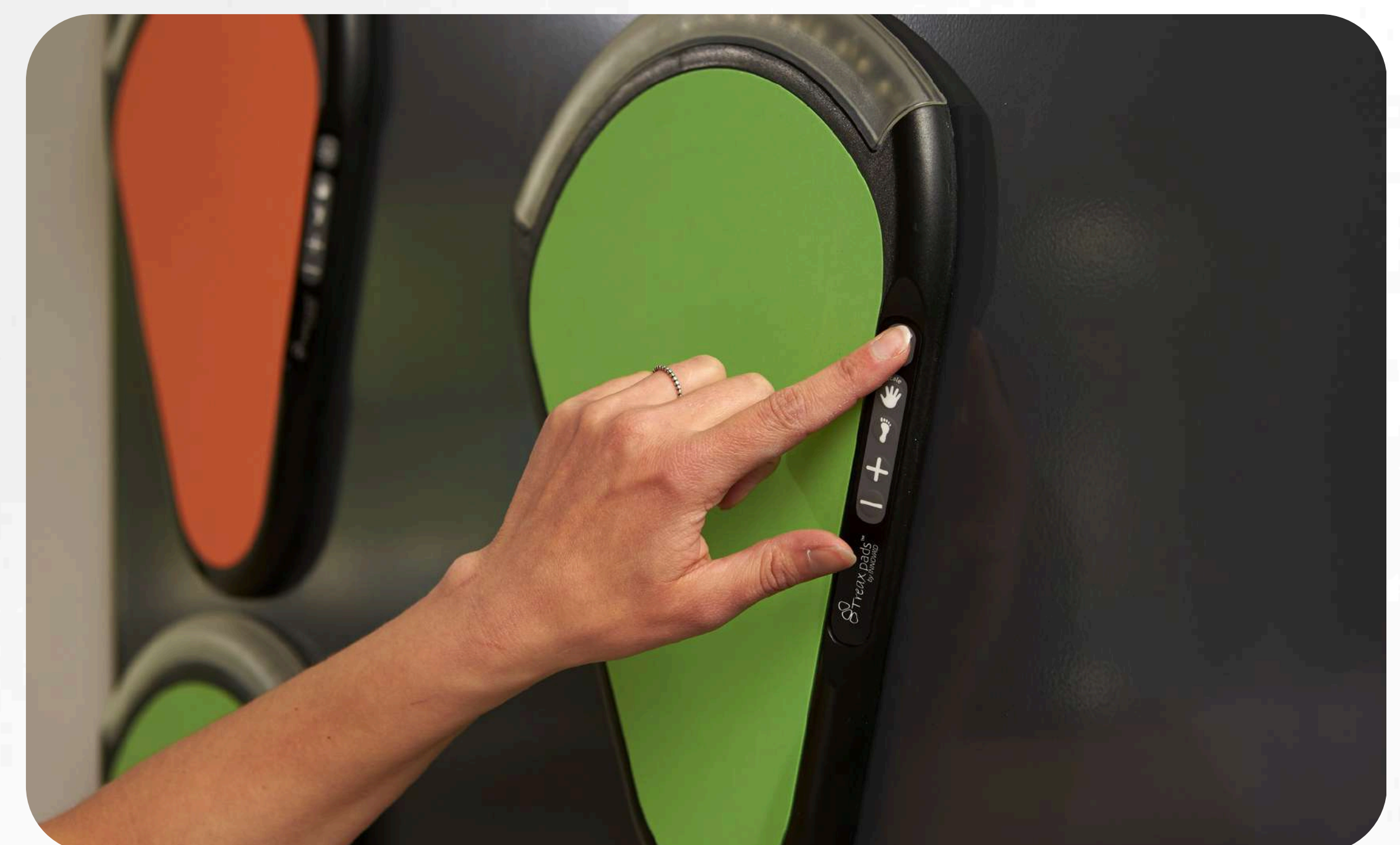
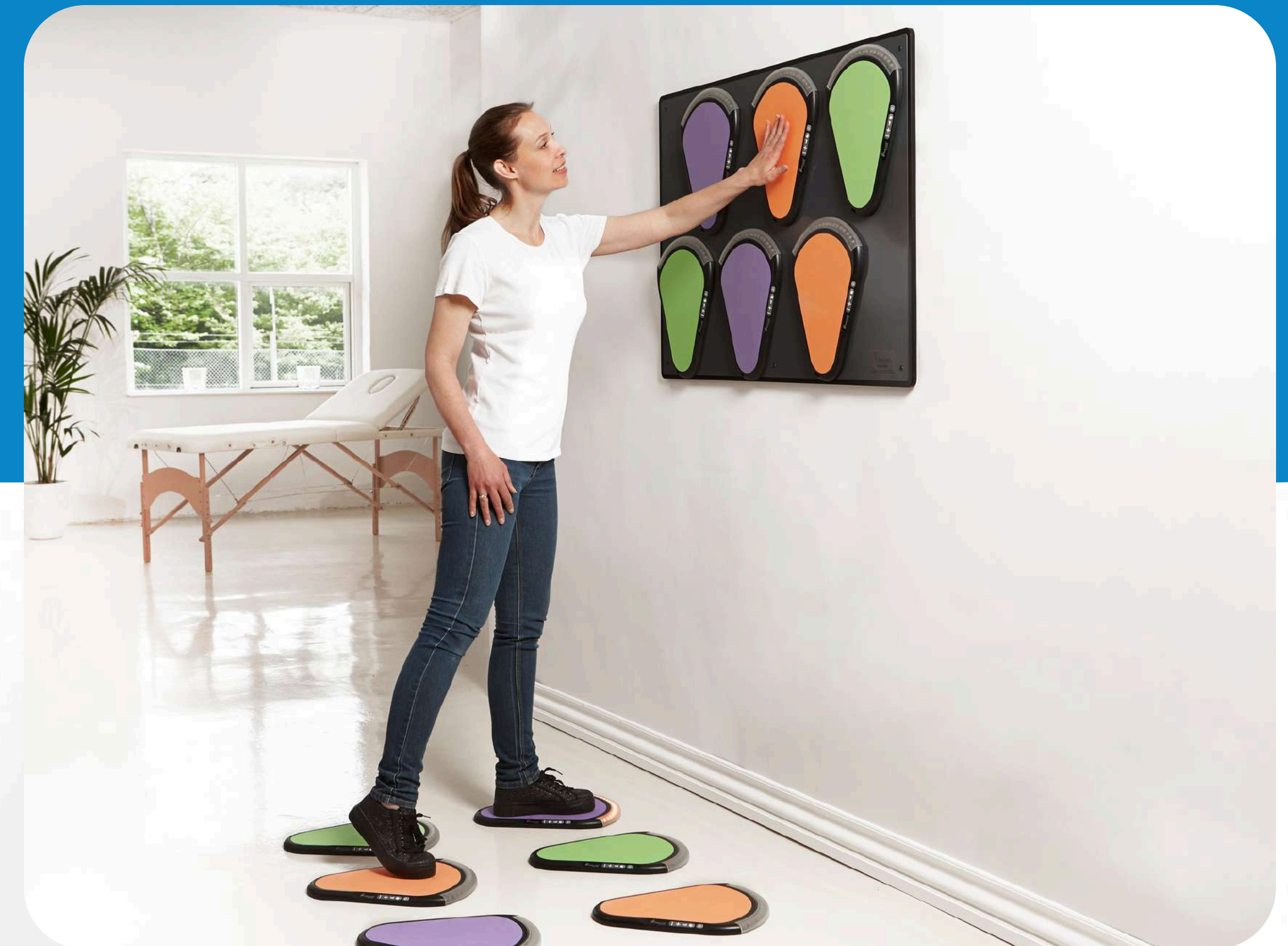
Floor setups train stepping, weight shift and gait, and the wall board adds upper-extremity reach and coordination.

Modular and scalable

- Start small and add pads as the patient progresses
- Combine sets for circuits and group sessions
- Larger setups enable two-person, social play
- Use with FES for the arms and ankle

Everyday practical

- Tool-free setup
- Clean with a damp cloth
- Disinfect with 85% alcohol

- Small Set, 6 pads
- Medium Set, 9 pads
- Large Set, 12 pads
- Extra Set, 3 pads, combines with any set
- Wall Board, 116 x 76 cm, holds 6 pads, magnetic
